

Tested, vaccinated or recovered: accepted types of evidence

To access this location, you require a valid type of evidence in accordance with the current COVID-19 ordinance. This rule does not apply to children up until the age of 10 and/or primary school children.



Tested

- PCR tests (72 hours)
- Antigen tests (48 hours)
- Self-tests including official confirmation (24 hours)



Vaccinated

- After the 21st day until no more than 3 months following the first dose
- Valid for 9 months following the first dose after having received all required vaccination doses

Accepted proofs of vaccination:

- Yellow vaccination record
- Vaccination card
- Printout of the data in the electronic vaccination record



Recovered

- Recovered from an infection within the previous six months
- Accepted types of evidence include antibody tests (not older than 3 months) or an official notice for self-isolation ('Absonderungsbescheid')
